## Sources for Community Assessment Data and Statistics

Local Sources:

- County health rankings/profiles- Alabama Department of Public Health ([alabamapublichealth.gov/healthstats/publications.html](http://alabamapublichealth.gov/healthstats/publications.html))
- Local (community, county) surveys- (should be recent, accurate, reliable): chambers of commerce, city/county governments, regional planning organizations, hospitals, colleges and universities, city and county school systems
- Conduct new surveys- focus groups, key individual interviews, phone surveys, mail surveys, community listening sessions or forums
